Re: TNG Energy Services' response to Governor Newsom's "Stay at Home" Order to combat the spread of the COVID-19 coronavirus


To All TNG Employees, Customers, Suppliers and Other Stakeholders

Yesterday evening, March 19, 2020 the governor of California issued Executive Order number N-33-20, referred to as the "Stay at Home Order" to all residents of California. This order has a wide degree of interpretation that may lead to confusion, uncertainty or even fear. What is important for you to know is that there is a key provision in the order stating that employees working in "critical infrastructure sectors" as identified by the federal government are to continue to work.
